

ORDINANCE #813

"AN ORDINANCE OF THE JOLIET PARK DISTRICT, WILL AND KENDALL COUNTIES,
ILLINOIS ASCERTAINING THE PREVAILING RATE OF WAGES FOR LABORERS,
WORKMAN AND MECHANICS EMPLOYED ON PUBLIC WORKS
OF SAID PARK DISTRICT"

WHEREAS, the Prevailing Wage Act (820 ILCS 130/0.01 et.seq.) requires that the Joliet Park District in Will and Kendall Counties investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics and other workers in the locality of said Park District employed in performing construction of public works, for said Park District,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE JOLIET PARK DISTRICT;

SECTION 1: To the extent and as required by "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by State, county, city or any public body or any political sub-division or by any one under contract for public works, " approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the Park District is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the Will and Kendall County area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of September 1, 2017, a copy of that determination being attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. The definition of any terms appearing in this Ordinance which are also used in aforesaid Act shall be the same as in said Act.

SECTION 2: Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of the park District to the extent required by the aforesaid Act.

SECTION 3: The Park District Secretary shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of this Park District this determination or any revisions of such prevailing rate of wage. A copy of this determination or of the current revised determination of prevailing rate of wages then in effect shall be attached to all contract specifications.

SECTION 4: The Park District Secretary shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

SECTION 5: The Park District Secretary shall promptly file a certified copy of this Ordinance with both the Secretary of State and the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

SECTION 6: The Park District Secretary shall cause to provide an electronic access to this notice on this public body's website with a hyperlink to the Illinois Department of Labor's (IDOL) uniform prevailing wage schedule for its locality of this Ordinance, and such electronic access shall constitute notice that the determination is effective and that this is the determination of this public body.

SECTION 7: The preamble of this Ordinance is hereby adopted as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 8: This Ordinance shall be considered severable, and the invalidity of any section, clause, paragraph, sentence, or provision of the Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other portion of this Ordinance.

SECTION 9: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval according to law.
