PROJECT TITLE: Highland Park Baseball Field Renovation Project

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Joliet Park District is requesting bids for Highland Park Baseball Field Renovation project. Scope of work includes material and installation for outfield and baseline fence, dugouts and backstop.

BID OPENING: Monday, April 8, 2024 at 10:00 A.M. Joliet Park District, Inwood Athletic Club, 3000 W. Jefferson Street, 1st Floor Board Room, Joliet, IL 60435.

Each bid must be placed in a sealed, opaque envelope with the Bidder's name, the date and time of the bid deadline and marked "**Sealed Bid: Highland Park Baseball Field**" and addressed to the Joliet Park District, Inwood Athletic Club, 3000 W. Jefferson Street, 2nd Floor, Joliet, IL 60435, Attention: Executive Director. Bids will be received until the time and at location specified above under "Bid Opening."

Bid forms and specifications for the Project can be emailed beginning, Thursday, March 28, 2024, by emailing a request to bstaab@jolietpark.org or available at the Joliet Park District's General Offices, located at 3000 W. Jefferson Street, Joliet, IL 60435 from 8:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays.

The Joliet Park District Board of Park Commissioners reserves the right to waive all technicalities, to accept or reject any or all bids, to accept only portions of a proposal and reject the remainder without disclosure for any reason. Failure to make such a disclosure will not result in accrual of any right, claim or cause of action by any Bidder against the Joliet Park District.

Bids shall not include federal excise tax or state sales tax for materials and equipment to be incorporated in, or fully consumed in the performance of, the work. An Exemption Certificate will be furnished by the Joliet Park District on request of the Bidder, for use in connection with this project only.

The Work of this Project is subject to the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/0.01 et seq. A prevailing wage determination has been made by the Illinois Department of Labor for public works projects in Will County. The Contract entered into for the Work will be drawn in compliance with said law and proposals should be prepared accordingly and provide for payment of all laborers, workmen, and mechanics needed to perform the Work at no less than the prevailing rate of wages (or the prevailing rate for legal holiday and overtime work) for each craft, type of worker, or mechanic.

The Contractor selected will also be required to comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, rules, regulations and executive orders including but not limited to those pertaining to equal employment opportunity.
