INVITATION TO BID

PROJECT TITLE: Wedgewood Golf Course Parking Lot and Path & Inwood Driveway & Parking Lot Improvements

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: **Wedgewood Golf Course**
The work shall consist of removing the existing bituminous parking lot to the aggregate base, removing a portion of the aggregate base to allow for the new bituminous pavement section, aggregate base repair of any areas not passing a proof roll, removal of limestone cart path and installation of new bituminous cart paths. Pavement markings, signage and restoration are also included. Cart path work will be bid as an add alternate.

Inwood Golf Course

The work shall consist of grinding the existing pavement, shaping and compacting grindings in place to be used as new base for new pavement, concrete loading area, minor ditch grading, pavement markings, signage and restoration.

Construction sequencing and completion dates will be critical for the completion of the projects

Contractor will be required to hire third party testing agency for the bituminous parking testing.

PRE-BID MEETING: There will be a “**MANDATORY**” pre-bid meeting on January 31, 2024, at 10:00AM at the Inwood Athletic Club located at 3000 W. Jefferson Street, Joliet, IL. Room to be determined. Bidders wishing to submit a bid must be present at this meeting to be eligible.

BID OPENING: The Joliet Park District will receive sealed bids at 3000 W. Jefferson Street, Joliet, IL 60435. All bids must be delivered to the Inwood Athletic Club, 2nd Floor, by 10:00 A.M. local time on February 13, 2024, when all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

BID REVIEW MEETING: It may be necessary to conduct bid review meetings with the contractor prior to bid recommendation. Contractors should be available February 14-16, 2024 for bid review meetings.

Bid forms and specifications for the said bids stated above can be picked up at the Joliet Park District General Offices at 3000 W. Jefferson Street, Joliet, IL 60435 from 8:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M., Monday through Friday excluding holidays.

Awards will be given based on the lowest responsible bid according to the current established bid policy of the commissioners of the Joliet Park District.

The Joliet Park District Board of Commissioners retains the right to waive any irregularities and reject any or all bids according to the District's bid policy.
