

## LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given to potential bidders that the Joliet Park District will be receiving sealed bids for the Multi-Purpose Center Remodel.

Bid Documents are available electronically at BHFx Imaging, 30 Butterfield Rd., Warrenville, IL 60555 ([www.BHFx.net](http://www.BHFx.net) or call at 630-393-0777), commencing on February 4, 2019. Paper copies are available for purchase at the cost of the bidders.

Each bid must be placed in a sealed, opaque envelope clearly marked "**Sealed Bid: Multi-Purpose Center Remodel**" and addressed to the Joliet Park District, 3000 West Jefferson Street, Joliet, IL, 60435, **Attention: Tom Carstens**. Bids will be received until 2:00 P.M. on **Wednesday, February 27, 2019**, at which time the bid proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Inwood Athletic Club Recreation Center, 3000 West Jefferson Street, Joliet, IL, 60435.

A pre-bid meeting will be held on **Wednesday, February 13, 2019 at 1:00 pm** at the Inwood Athletic Club Recreation Center, 3000 West Jefferson St., Joliet IL, 60435. It is highly recommended that you attend this meeting, but it is not mandatory. Failure to attend and you will miss important discussions about the project.

The Joliet Park District Board of Park Commissioners reserves the right to waive all technicalities, to accept or reject any or all bids, to accept only portions of a proposal and reject the remainder without disclosure for any reason. Failure to make such a disclosure will not result in accrual of any right, claim or cause of action by any bidder against the Joliet Park District.

Bids shall not include federal excise tax or state sales tax for materials and equipment to be incorporated in, or fully consumed in the performance of, the Work. An Exemption Certificate will be furnished by the Joliet Park District on request of the bidder, for use in connection with this Project only.

The Work of this Project is subject to the Illinois *Prevailing Wage Act*, 820 ILCS 130/0.01 *et seq.* A prevailing wage determination has been made by the Park District, which is the same as that determined by the Illinois Department of Labor for public works projects in Will County. The Contract entered into for the Work will be drawn in compliance with said law and proposals should be prepared accordingly and provide for payment of all laborers, workmen, and mechanics needed to perform the Work at no less than the prevailing rate of wages (or the prevailing rate for legal holiday and overtime work) for each craft, type of worker, or mechanic.

All bid proposals must be accompanied by a bid bond or bank cashier's check payable to the Joliet Park District for ten percent (10%) of the amount of the bid as provided in the Instructions to bidders. No proposals or bids will be considered unless accompanied by such bond or check.

The Contractor selected will also be required to comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, rules, regulations and executive orders including but not limited to those pertaining to equal employment opportunity.
